Bone Graft Post-Operative Information

- **Do Not Rinse for 2 Days**
- **Avoid Eating on Area for 10-14 days**
- **Avoid Brushing Area until you return for post op.**

When Bone Grafting is placed:

-The socket is filled with bone chips.

-A collagen membrane is placed over of the bone graft while healing. This will look like a sponge or blood clot over the area.

-The area will have stitches that may or may not need to be removed.

-In some cases tissue glue may be placed over the grafting area. This will look like a scab and will begin to flake off. Do not pull at the glue. Let it fall off on its own.

-You may experience a sensation of “crunching on sand.” This is normal as some of the bone grafting material will work its way out.
